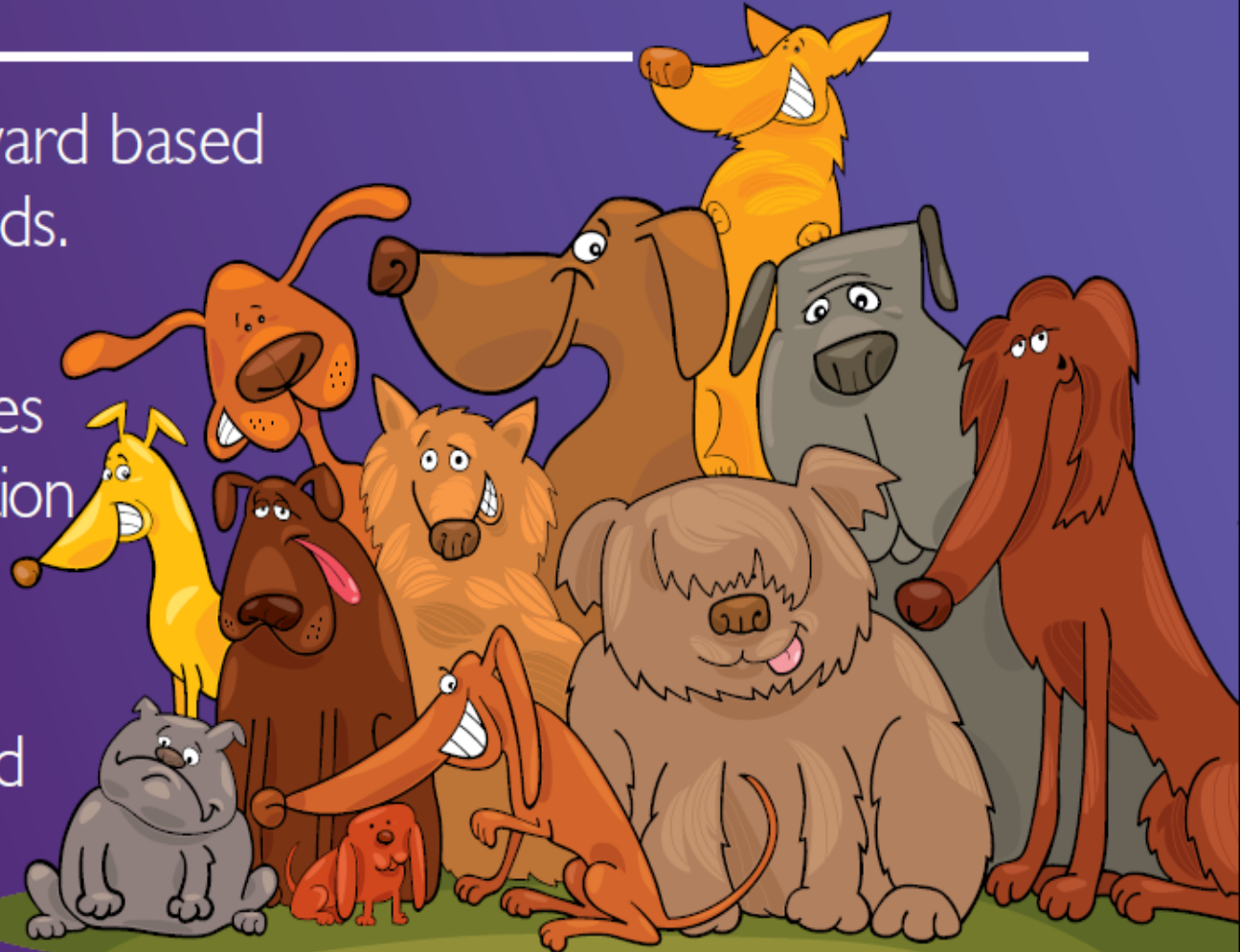

SOME DO'S AND DON'T FOR CLUB NIGHTS

DO's

- ✓ Do make sure your dog is wearing a collar and lead complete with an identity disc.
- ✓ Do exercise your dog before coming to class.
- ✓ Do ensure you have a supply of tasty titbits preferably in a sealed container.
- ✓ Do wear sensible footwear (flat shoes or trainers) no loose flapping clothing.
- ✓ Do ensure your dogs inoculation certificate is up to date. (Must be shown on enrolment).
- ✓ Always pick up after your dog. (Dog waste bin on adjacent footpath to the left of the hall entrance).

DONT'S

- ✗ Don't feed your dog just before coming to club.
- ✗ Don't let your dog urinate within the Church Hall boundaries.
- ✗ Don't bring your dog to class if:
 - She is in season
 - He/she has been unwell in the last 24 hours
 - You suspect that he/she has kennel cough
- ✗ Don't let your dog be a nuisance to other members, their dogs or local residents.
